FWSA Waiver and Release Agreement

ASSUMPTION OF RISK

I am aware that participation in the FWSA Mt. Bachelor trip listed above, has, in addition to the usual risks, dangers and hazards associated with travel, alpine skiing and snowboarding, certain additional risks, dangers and hazards including, but not limited to: boarding, riding and disembarking ski lifts; changing weather conditions; exposed rock, earth, ice, trees or other natural objects; the condition of snow or ice on or beneath the skiing surface; changes or variations in the skiing surface or subsurface, including changes due to man-made or artificial snow, streams, creeks, glaciers and exposed holes in the snow pack above streams, creeks or glaciers; impact or collision with natural objects or ski lift towers, snow making equipment, snow grooming equipment or other structures, objects or equipment used in connection with skiing, snowboarding or ski racing; impact or collision with other skiers or spectators; avalanches; the failure to ski or snowboard safely or within one's own ability or within designated areas; negligence of other skiers and negligence on the part of the organizations or their staff. I am aware that the risks, dangers and hazards referred to above exist throughout the ski area and that many are unmarked. I FREELY ACCEPT AND FULLY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS AND THE POSSIBILITY OF PERSONAL INJURY, DEATH, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR LOSS, RESULTING THEREFROM.

WARNING

Skiers and Boarders assume the risk of any injury to person or property resulting from any of the inherent dangers and risks of skiing and may not recover from any ski area operator for any injury resulting from any of the inherent dangers and risks of skiing including: changing weather conditions; existing and changing snow conditions; bare spots; rocks; stumps; trees; collisions with natural objects, man-made objects, or skiers; variations in terrain; and the failure of skiers to ski within their own abilities.

The Ski Safety Act was amended in 2004 to include cliffs, EXTREME TERRAIN, JUMPS and FREESTYLE TERRAIN as inherent risks of the sport.

I am aware and acknowledge that racing and training and practice for racing have inherent dangers and risks for any competitor. Race courses may be icy, rutted and bumpy. I assume the risk of all course conditions including, but not limited to weather and snow conditions, course construction or layout, and obstacles. I am required to inspect physically and visually the course and area of competition prior to the beginning of competition and, by using the course, assume the risk of all course conditions. I am voluntarily participating in these races and training and practice for the race with the full knowledge of the dangers and risks involved and hereby agree to accept any and all risks or injury, paralysis, or death that may result.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration for my being permitted to participate in the **Far West Ski Association (FWSA) Mt. Bachelor trip** at the Mt. Bachelor Ski Resort in March - April, 2007, I hereby agree to the following:

- To waive any and all rights and claims for damages I have or may have in the future against **FWSA, Mt. Bachelor, The Riverhouse, Ski.Com**, it's employees, affiliated organizations and companies and the United States Forest Service, and their insurance carriers, their agents, representatives, assignees officers directors and shareholders, tour operators, travel agents and all sponsors, and their owners, landowners, directors, officers, agents, and employees, and their representatives (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Releasee");
- To release the Releasee from any and all liability for any loss, damage, injury or expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees) that I may suffer or that my next of kin may suffer as a result of my participation in this ski trip, due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence of any kind or nature, whether foreseen or unforeseen, arising directly or indirectly out of any damage, loss, injury, paralysis, or death to me or my property, breach of contract, or breach of any statutory or other duty of care except claims based upon willful or intentional misconduct;
- To hold harmless and indemnify the Releasee from any and all liability for any property damage or personal injury to any third party, resulting from my participation in the Ski Week;
- This agreement shall be effective and binding upon my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, assignees and representatives in the event of my death or incapacity.
- If any part of this contract is determined to be unenforceable for any reason, it is intended that all other terms will be enforced in all other circumstances.
- I agree and understand that this Release Agreement is applicable to each and every day that I participate in this ski trip.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ AND CLEARLY UNDERSTAND THIS RELEASE OF LIABILITY PRIOR TO SIGNING IT. I AM AWARE THAT BY SIGNING THIS RELEASE OF LIABILITY I AM WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, WHICH I OR MY HEIRS, NEXT OF KIN, EXECUTORS, ADMINISTRATORS AND ASSIGNEES MAY HAVE AGAINST THE RELEASEE. I VOLUNTARILY SIGN THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE AGREEMENT.
