VERTICAL FEET COMPETITION:

While our event is 24-hour, "Because cancer never sleeps," we will have 3 time slots available for the vertical feet competition (GOLD 24-hour, 1PM- 1PM), (SILVER 18-hour, 7PM- 1PM), and (BRONZE 6-hour, 7AM- 1PM), with everyone finishing at 1PM- Closing Ceremonies will begin at 1:30 PM, when we will hand out awards and prizes.

Each participant will wear an event bib and have a vertical feet card that we will be used to track runs at both the upper and lower bowls. The Lower Bowl Chair will remain open overnight
