#### Oct. 16 (Sunday)

Moderate 5.4 mile hike to Harts Cove, 900' elevation gain.

**Time:** Meet us at: 8:30 am at the Barbur Blvd. Transit Center, or 10:00 am at the Trailhead.



#### To get there:

From the junction with Highway 18 (just north of Lincoln City), drive north 4 miles on Highway 101.

Just before a crest, turn left on the gravel road, Cascade Head Road (Road 1861).

After about 4 miles is the parking lot for Harts Cove.

The well-graded trail switchbacks down



through a young hemlock forest. The path contours amid 6-foot-thick Sitka spruce and Hemlock giants. A bench @ the 1.4 mile mark offers a glimpse ahead to Harts Cove's headland.

We cross the Chitwood Creek (bridge is out), and in another 0,6 mile we enter the headland's fabulously scenic meadow, once part of the Taggard homestead.

# **Turning Skills**

#### Safety

#### Vision of Skiing in the 21st Century

Safety

Building up on the idea of a new vision for skiing in the 21st century, started in the July/August 2005 issue of "Lift Lines", resorts could make the slopes **safer** by providing more opportunities for us to practice **controlled turning,** by simply setting up a variety of **fun obstacles** on the slopes. This would not only make the slopes more **fun**, but would also **slow traffic down**, make the slopes **safer**, and lift lines **shorter**.

Urge ski areas to implement this idea, in any of a number of ways. Here's just one of them:





# Use whisker gates

Whisker gates can be used in place of traffic cones, in an **obstacle** maze.

They can also be used in place of gates for a **simple race-training course.** 

These whisker gates can be skied over with no damage to the skis or the gates.

All three have a variety of terrain, from easy cruisers to great tree skiing!



#### Warren Miller's new movie & the Canadian Ski Safari

**Available:** Sept .1 - Nov. 6, 2005. These are real season passes, valid all season. If you ski less than 13 days a year, better get a 10-time pass instead.

Cost: \$425 per person.

**Who qualifies:** Any group of 4 people, ages 23-64 at time of purchase. Our club will help you pair up with someone. For other ages, there are even better deals.

Question: Do last year's pass-holders qualify for a discount?

**Answer:** Yes. You will be able to purchase the 4Buy4 Pass this year for only \$400. A "Pass Verification Code" will be sent via mail to 2004/2005 passholders in September. This PVC code will assure that the passholder receives the best price possibile. It is also used if a passholder wants to select last year's picture to use on this year's pass.

Question: I only had a 10 time pass. Any discounts for me?

**Answer:** Yes. You also have a "Pass Verification Code" assigned to you, and you also qualify for a discount.

Question: *I did not receive my PVC code in the email. Where can I get it?* **Answer:** Go to the Meadows web site, and look it up there. You will be asked for your full name and birth date. Look it up in the right column at: www.skihood.com/Pricing/SeasonPasses/4Buy4/default.aspx.

Question: There are only 2 or 3 of us. Can we still buy the 4Buy4?

**Answer:** No. You need a complete group of 4. One person has to start the process by veing the group organizer and entering everyone's name and email address on the Meadows' web site. Others will then make their individual payments via credit card.

**Question:** *Do I need to give my credit card number to the Group Organizer?* **Answer:** No. Everyone will make an individual payment directly to Mt. Hood Meadows, using the secure web site process.

# How t o Find Partners for a Group
