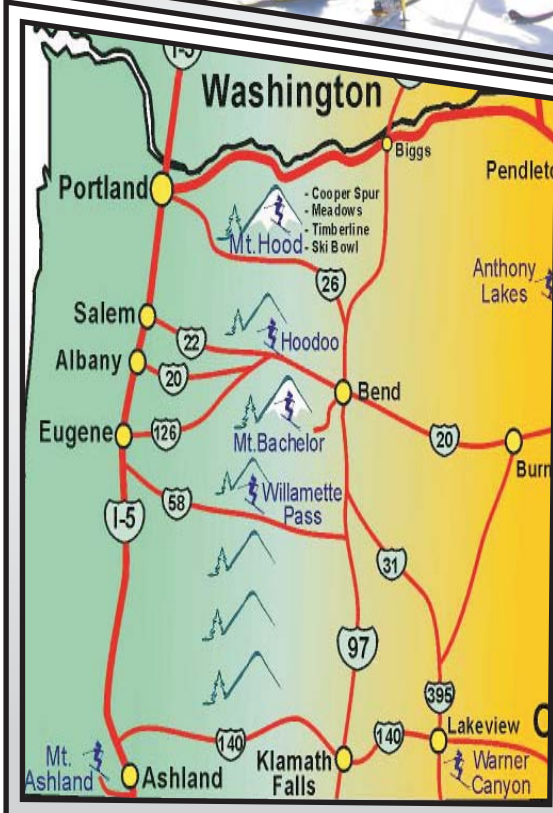

Sunny Southern Oregon A Mt. High bus trip February 15 - 18, 2008.

February 15-18, 2008. (3 days /3 nights)

A fun 3-day trip over Presidents' Day weekend, where you can really get to know other club members, both on the bus and on the slopes. Our bus trips are usually among the most fun and the least expensive trips.

Start the trip on Friday evening. Let's call that "Day 0" (because most people can work that day, and leave after work, and we don't do any skiing on that day). That day, we would travel about 6 hours south of Portland, to the town of Lakeview (east of Klamath Falls). We'll stay in town, at the Lakeview Lodge (6 miles from the ski area).

The next day, Saturday, would be counted as "Day 1" of the trip.

Day 1 (Saturday): Ski **Warner Canyon**, then go to Ashland.
Warner Canyon is open only on weekends. There are no crowds. Excellent powder skiing. Great views. Warm family atmosphere.
At the end of the day, drive straight west, thru Klamath Falls, to Ashland.

Day 2 (Sunday): Ski **Mt. Shasta**, then go back to Ashland.
Mt. Shasta Ski Park consists of 3 separate hills. One of them is all green and light blue trails for beginners. The other two hills are a mix of blue and black runs. The weather tends to be nice and sunny. Hey, this is California!
At the end of the day, drive back to Ashland.

Day 3 (Monday): Ski **Mt. Ashland**, then drive back home. Should be home by about 9 - 10 pm.
Mt. Ashland has a variety of terrain, including an awesome bowl, tree-skiing, challenging bumps, and long cruising blue trails. See how many trails and/or lifts you can spot that bear names related to Shakespeare.

Price: Approximately **\$250** for lodging and transportation, plus approx. \$38 per lift ticket (exact price tba later).

The trip price is based on 26 people. For each 2 people that sign up over that number, the price for everyone will go down by \$4. (For example, for 32 people it would cost \$238 each, and at 42 people it would cost only \$218 each!) So, let's make sure everyone goes on this trip! The more of us, the cheaper it will be.
