SKI THE NORTHWEST CHALLENGE

You can participate in this unique Northwest Council challenge, to ski or snowboard a minimum of 7 ski areas anywhere in Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Alaska, British Columbia, and Alberta in a single season. At the end of the season, mail in your **lift tickets** or **credit-card receipts** showing proof of purchase of lift-tickets. Entries and proof of qualification must be received by the Council no later than June 15. The drawing will take place at the June Council meeting. You must be 18 years old or older to enter.

The names of all who meet the minimum of 7 resorts visited, will be posted on our web site, ranked by the number of total resorts. Everyone who completes this challenge will qualify for the Council's year-end drawing for prizes – equipment, services, and lift tickets for the following season. The more resorts you visit, the more valuable prizes you will qualify for.
