The Mt. Hood Cultural Center & Museum will host a special **Steiner Cabins Celebration Open House on Saturday, October 18, from 1:00 to 3:30 pm.** 



A featured presentation by filmmaker and Steiner Cabin owner **Ian McCluskey** will begin at **2:00 pm**. The event is both a chance to learn more about Mt. Hood's history and a way to support ongoing preservation of these iconic log cabins.

The afternoon will include a **fundraising raffle** with many Mt. Hood—themed prizes. Lucky winners may walk away with:

- An overnight stay in an authentic Steiner built cabin,
- A private tour of the historic Fogelbo Steiner Log Home in Portland and lunch at the Nordic NW/Soder Broder cafe,
